DIVISION ONE TEAMS

Medals were awarded to the top three Clubs in Division One irrespective of the number of completing teams.

DIVISION TWO, THREE, B & C PLUS TEAMS

*Medals were awarded to the top three Clubs in Divisions Two, Three, 'B' and 'C Plus' dependent on the number of completing teams, i.e. 10 or more completing teams = First, Second & Third;
6 to 9 completing teams = First & Second;
5 or fewer teams = First.*

*In the event of teams scoring the same number of points:
Taking the best 4 races (U11's best 3 races), where one team finished higher 3 times (U11's twice) that team won. If both teams finished higher twice, the positions of the last counting runners in each of the 4 races (U11's 3 races) determined the winning team.*
