



**Manchester Area Cross Country League #5. Saturday 10th February 2018.
Athletics Facility, Wythenshawe Park, Wythenshawe Road, Manchester, M23 0AB.**

- Situated 6.8 miles from the City Centre.
- By road: Leave M60 at Junction 5, or M56 Junction 3 (onto Princess Parkway).
- By bus: Bus 101 from Princess Parkway (heading from City Centre).
- Bus 179 along Altrincham Road A560 (from Stockport direction).
- Bus 370 from Didsbury along Wythenshawe Road B5167, or from Altrincham Interchange along Wythenshawe Road.
- Bus stops are located nearby on Princess Parkway, Wythenshawe Road and Altrincham Road.
- By train, Metro tram stations less than half a mile away at Moor Road, Wythenshawe Road junction. Also further along Moor Road, nearer to Altrincham Rd and Tesco.
- **Please make use of public transport, cycling or car sharing when ever possible.**

The main gate entrance to the Park is off Wythenshawe Road A5167 with the Hall and cafe and most other facilities, with the main car park through the park near the stables and nurseries, various paths lead to the Athletics facility and sports fields.

The Athletics Facility entrance is 300 metres further along Wythenshawe Road (B5167) from the main park entrance, with parking adjacent, and overspill in the throws field.

Venue Facilities; Male toilets, showers and changing are in the quadrant building in the car park.

With female toilets and changing in the track area building (no showers). Plus portaloo's at the track.

Parking in the park at the designated car parks;

N.B. There will be traffic management / parking stewards on duty at the facility entrance on Wythenshawe road and also within the car park and overspill field.

: Parking at the Athletics Facility; is in the track facility car-park, will fill up with young athlete parking initially, but more spaces will become available for men as kids leave, on a rolling basis.

Stewards will control the parking and also the parking in adjacent throws field.

: Parking via the main park entrance, the summer parking in the field to the left, opposite the golf course and bowls, with some limited park road side spaces, near the Tennis / bowls.

: Car park opposite the stables, just a few hundred metres walk to the track and start area.

N.B. If car parks are temporarily full then use the adjacent roads of Orton, Northolt, Sledmoor etc

N.B. Allow a little extra time when parking in the park car parks, to get to the start.
